Fig. 4 Normalized On-Resistance Vs. Temperature




Fig 5. Typical Capacitance vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage




Fig 6. Typical Gate Charge vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Fig 7 Typical Source-to-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




Fig 8. Maximum Safe Operating Area




Fig 9. Maximum Drain Current Vs. Case Temperature




Fig 10a. Switching Time Test Circuit




Fig 10b. Switching Time Waveforms












Fig 11. Maximum Effective Transient Thermal Impedance, Junction-to-Case






